Avenues for Hope provides a boost to housing nonprofits in Southwest Idaho

Nonprofits across Southwest Idaho are looking for your support as they raise money needed to provide critical housing and supportive services during the 13th annual Avenues for Hope Housing Challenge.

Donations made during the 20-day online fundraising campaign allow organizations like the WCA in Boise to provide safety for those escaping domestic violence and sexual assault. The WCA's emergency shelter offers survivors a place to stay so they don't have to choose between being homeless or living with violence at home.

"The shelter is the most expensive service we provide, but it's also one of the most important," said Beatrice Black, chief executive officer at the WCA. "Avenues for Hope ensures we can provide a safe place for the person escaping a dangerous situation, while raising awareness of this issue in our communities."

The WCA is one of 49 nonprofits in Southwest Idaho participating in this year's campaign to help chronically and temporarily homeless, domestic violence survivors, veterans, people with disabilities, vulnerable youth, seniors, and low-income Idahoans. Over the past 12 years, Avenues for Hope has helped raise more than \$12 million.

"We are deeply grateful for the many nonprofit organizations and dedicated people working across Idaho to help those who have become unemployed, a victim of domestic violence, disabled, evicted, or otherwise cannot afford a place of shelter," said Gerald M. Hunter, president of Idaho Housing and Finance. "The Avenues for Hope campaign is our annual opportunity to help support these critical nonprofits and the thousands they assist."
