Overview

HUD recommends grantees select targeted census tracks in high need of assistance of a stabilizing impact. Idaho has determined new target area selection criteria. This is in response to the current status of Idaho's housing market and determination there is an adequate need to expand the eligible census tracts to meet the needs of neighborhoods in need of stabilization.

To stabilize a neighborhood, subrecipients/developers will be required to identify multiple properties within a three block area in the target areas to receive NSP3 assistance (see target area data). Target areas have been characterized by moderate to low demand, a market insufficient to correct itself yet not collapsed.

New Target Area Selection Criteria

To be targeted for funding, census tracts need to meet the following criteria:

Area Benefit Eligibility

Area Median Household income in census tract is below published NSP 120% AMI income limits found at https://www.hudexchange.info/resource/3680/nsp-income-limits/

Percentage of housing constructed before 1979 in census tract is above 70%


Percentage of cost burdened households (greater than 50% towards housing cost) above 30%
