Notice of 2023 CHDO Operating Assistance Grant Application &
CHDO Certification Deadline**

IHFA is now accepting applications from community-based, non-profit affordable housing development organizations (CHDOs) for 2023 CHDO Certification status, and CHDO Operating Assistance Grants. CHDO Operating Grant funding is split between all eligible CHDO's which apply and are approved for funding. The amount of funding available to each CHDO depends on individual scoring, as well as the number of approved applications. Individual grants cannot exceed \$50,000.

The Organization must be a 2023 IHFA-Certified CHDO to be eligible to receive a CHDO Operating Assistance Grant. Organization must submit all requested documents on the CHDO Certification and Operating Grant Application Checklist, as well as the Full CHDO Certification Checklist, and the CHDO Operating Grant Application, which can found on the HOME Programs website here: <https://www.idahohousing.com/federal-programs/home-program/> or in the online Procorem Work Center (online portal), once a work center portal has been requested for application submission.

Deadline for completed applications is 5 p.m. MST, September 1, 2023. Applications will only be accepted electronically. Developers of affordable housing should contact the HOME Programs Department to request access to the portal system for electronic application submission, or for application related questions.
