IHFA is the HUD grantee and administrator for the balance of Idaho's HOME American Rescue Plan (ARP). This program is a federally funded affordable housing development assistance and supportive services program.

These funds are available for direct supportive services only. For those applying to develop housing, supportive services is being made available under the "PSH RFP."

Direct supportive services* - \$750,000

*Case management (benefits & wages) is the eligible service.

The application is open from May 15 – June 15, 2025, and is limited to no more than four (4) non-profits, who have previously been funded with HOME ARP supportive services. The grant funds are for July 1, 2025 – June 30, 2026.
