## Notice of HOME American Rescue Plan (ARP) Grant Application Deadline

IHFA is the HUD grantee and administrator for the balance of Idaho's HOME American Rescue Plan (ARP). This program is a federally funded affordable housing development assistance and supportive services program.

IHFA is now accepting applications from non-profit organizations for general operating, capacity building, and direct supportive services funding. Information on HOME ARP can be found in the HOME ARP Administrative Plan:

The approximate available funding for the three different grant application(s):

Non-profit operating - \$400,000

Non-profit capacity building - \$825,000

Direct supportive services\* - \$3,000,000

*\*Case management, HUD Certified Housing Counseling and Search, and Financial Services are the eligible services.*
