## Notice of HOME American Rescue Plan (ARP) Grant Application Deadline

IHFA is the HUD grantee and administrator for the balance of Idaho's HOME American Rescue Plan (ARP). This program is a federally funded affordable housing development assistance and supportive services program.

IHFA is now accepting applications from non-profit organizations for direct supportive services funding. Information on HOME ARP can be found in the HOME ARP Administrative Plan: <https://www.idahohousing.com/federal-programs/home-arp/>

These funds are available for direct supportive services only. *For those applying to develop housing, supportive services is being made available under the "PSH RFP."*

Direct supportive services\* - \$750,000

*\*Case management (benefits & wages) is the eligible service.*

The application is open from May 15 – June 15, 2025, and is limited to no more than four (4) non-profits, who have previously been funded with HOME ARP supportive services. The grant funds are for July 1, 2025 – June 30, 2026.
