These notices shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for activities to be undertaken by Idaho Housing and Finance Association.

## REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about April 19th, 2021 Idaho Housing and Finance Association and the City of Caldwell will submit separate requests to HUD for the release of HOME funds under Title II of the Cranston-Gonzales National Affordable Housing Act, as amended through 1998, and CDBG funds under Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, Public Law 93-383, as amended; 42 U.S.5301 et seq., to undertake a project for the purpose of new construction of 3 single-family homes which will provide affordable housing. The approximate 0.21-acre project site is vacant land located at 301 East Freepoint Street, Caldwell, Idaho 83605.

## FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

Idaho Housing and Finance Association and the City of Caldwell have determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. All comments received by April 18th, 2021 will be considered by IHFA and the City of Caldwell prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds. Comments should specify which notice they are addressing.

## RELEASE OF FUNDS

IHFA and the City of Caldwell certifies to HUD that Cory Phelps, in his capacity as Vice President Project Finance and Certifying Officer, and Garret L. Nancolas, in his capacity as Mayor of the City of Cadlwell, Idaho, consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have

been satisfied. HUD's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities, and allows IHFA to use Program funds.

#### OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

HUD will accept objections to its release of funds and the IHFA and City of Caldwell certifications for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the RE (b) the RE has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58; (c) the grant recipient has committed funds or incurred costs not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by HUD; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58) and shall be addressed to HUD at CPD Director, 1220 SW 3rd Ave., Suite 400, Portland, OR 97204-2825. Potential objectors should contact HUD to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
