NEW ITEMS:

1. Convene meeting/roll call.

- Region 3 is still vacant. Lori talked to Shawn and Kristina about filling this vacancy. Amy suggested Ali from Jesse Tree might be interested. They will follow up to try to get this filled.

2. Review & Finalize Minutes:

- Motion to accept June 13, 2019 minutes as presented, Jordan was only person on the call at this time. Jordan approved meeting minutes.

FOLLOW-UP ITEMS:

1. 2018 System Performance Measures Report

- This is a graphical presentation for the IHCC board can use to create strategies based on data and will be presented at the next IHCC meeting. No approval needed by the DCR&E committee.
- The goal is for all CoCs to make homelessness rare, brief and non-recurring.
- SPM is almost a third of the points on the application. (60 out of 200)
- HUD wants to know the strategies on the application. Wants 5% decrease or increase in each measure.
- Measure 1a & 1b -LOT homeless:
 - Jordan doing housing specialist work. People coming from ES quickly or if they come after being in ES after 30 days have about 50/50 that are ready for housing or have successful outcomes.
- Measure 2 –Returns:
 - People are raising rents and cannot sustain. More units need to be built.
 - Need better relationships with landlords so they understand issue/ increase awareness to do a subsidized unit.
 - Jordan struggling with housing availability. Susan says people have vouchers but cannot find a place to take them.
 - Jenn –Housing trust fund. Subsidized housing with developers to dedicate x units for homeless/low income.
- Measure 3a & 3b –homelessness count:
 - PIT count: Unsheltered is almost the same as ES + TH.
- Measure 4 –Income growth CoC projects only:
 - Only PSH and some RRH.
 - Will only be in this report if stayers are in over a year and has annual assessment.
 - Suggested strategies:
 - Further Education; career counselling; college housing; get part-time work to supplement SSI/SSDI. Suggest to temp services, have clients actively looking for work.
 - Susan –R5 has GED program, refers to ISU ‘Start Program’.
 - Pay for technical school or trade programs with scholarships.
- Measure 5 –First time homeless:
 - Need more HP funding. What risk factors: Poor money management, loss job, health care costs, child care costs, criminal record, domestic violence.
