

Notice is hereby given that on June 4, 2020, Idaho Housing and Finance Association took up the following substantial amendments to the 2020 Consolidated Plan.

On March 27, 2020, the United State Congress passed the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act, H.R. 748). The bill provided additional funding to rapidly respond to COVID-19 and the economic and housing impacts caused by the pandemic. All CARES Act related funding awards under this notice must prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus. Funding from Idaho Housing and Finance Association are intended for investments into COVID-19 prevention and containment efforts for shelter, including, but not limited to, medically indicated services and supplies, such as testing and hand washing stations, enhancements to existing shelter facilities, and expanding isolation capacity. These special ESG-CV funds are also to be used to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus pandemic (COVID-19) among individuals and families who are homeless or receiving homeless assistance; and to support additional homeless assistance and homelessness prevention activities to mitigate the impacts of COVID-19 in Idaho.

Idaho Housing and Finance Association anticipates receiving **\$3,828,517** in Emergency Solutions Grant-CV CARES Act funding. Idaho Housing and Finance Association is using an expedited process that permits a public notice as the only requirement. The planned breakdown of funding throughout the state of Idaho will be as follows:

- 1. Allocate 80% of funding (\$3,062,813), to Regions 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6.**
- 2. Allocate 20% of funding (\$765,704), to Region 7 in coordination with the Boise City/Ada County Continuum of Care.**
