Notice of HOME American Rescue Plan (ARP) Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) Proposal Deadline

IHFA is the HUD grantee and administrator for the balance of Idaho's HOME American Rescue Plan (ARP). This program is a federally funded affordable housing development assistance and supportive services program.

IHFA is now accepting proposals from non-profit organizations for development, capacity building, and direct supportive services funding. Information on HOME ARP/HOME PSH can be found in the HOME ARP Administrative Plan Chapter 5: <https://www.idahohousing.com/federal-programs/home-arp/>

The approximate available funding for the PSH development application:

Development – up to \$14,000,000 (between two federal sources)

Non-profit capacity building – up to \$500,000

Direct supportive services* - up to \$2,000,000

**Case management is the eligible service. This funding covers salaries and benefits only.*

To ensure the requirements of HOME ARP/HOME PSH are met, IHFA will require attendance at one (1) RFP workshop. *Applications will not be accepted from interested agencies without attending the workshop.* The dates of workshops are in Mountain Time and as follows:

Workshops:

June 2 11:00 am – 12:00 pm MT

June 4 1:00 pm – 2:00 pm MT

June 6 9:00 am – 10:00 am MT

All workshops will be held virtually and the proposal deadline is 11:59 p.m. MT, August 15, 2025.
